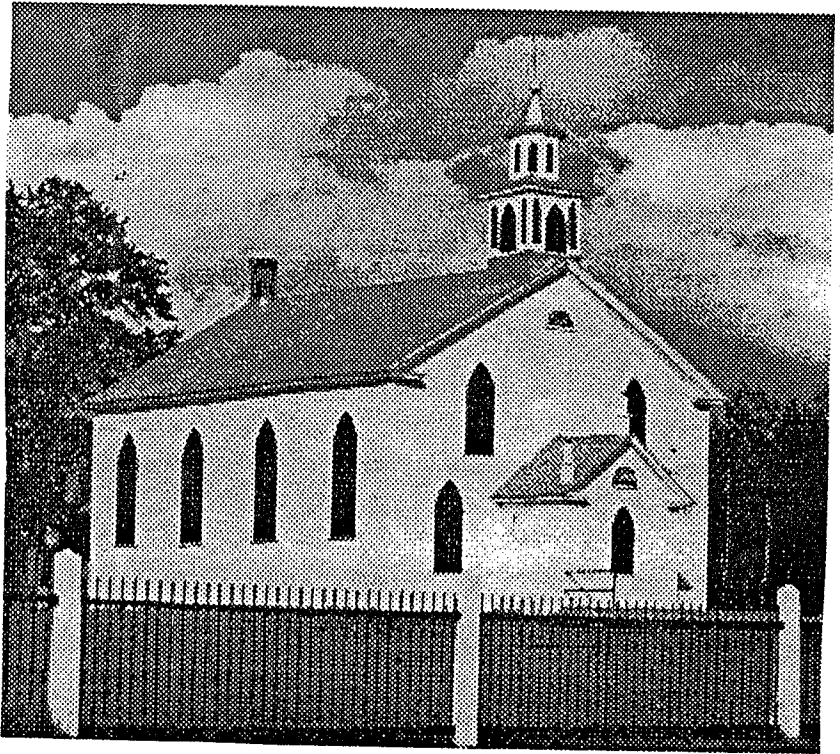

The drop in interest rates on the GIC investments will force us to be prudent as we carry out the maintenance jobs. There will be no cancellation of essential jobs such as painting of the roof, etc. The condition of the concrete entrance platform and steps is the only project which should be attended to now. This will be a major expense and we may not tackle it for a year or two. If we decide to build a new entrance we may have to make a special appeal to help finance it. We are pleased that Philip Wood and Gregg Edwards have agreed to serve on our Committee.
